## **MISSION DISCIPLESHIP: RECHOVOT**

## A Network of Discipleship/Aliyah Houses throughout Israel

(Genesis 26:22 And he moved from there and dug another well, and they did not quarrel over it. So he called its name Rechovoth, saying, "For now the LORD has made room for us, and we shall be fruitful in the land.")

The purpose of these houses is to help Messianic believers integrate into Israeli society and grow as strong and healthy disciples of Yeshua. The houses are for new immigrants, as well as Israeli residents, for the purposes of discipleship, deliverance and inner healing.

Each house has the following:

- 1. House parent / Overseer
- 2. Discipleship volunteers who come from overseas and serve 1-3 months
- 3. Disciples

All people stay at the house without financial obligation, but with expectations and duties that must be upheld and done with excellence. All expenses are covered, including food. Disciples are welcome to hold jobs, as long as they have time to fulfill their program/house obligations. The number of disciples in each house will be dependent upon the size of the house. i.e. Arad Ezra House: BR 1: House Parent; BR 2 Volunteer(s); BR 3 – 3 disciples; BR 4 - 3 disciples. Houses will be exclusively male or female. Volunteers can be a single or a couple.

Outline of Duties:

- 1. House Parent: Oversight of all details
  - a. Spiritual / Counseling oversight for Disciples
  - b. House corporate prayer/worship
  - c. Bill paying
  - d. International Volunteer Management and oversight
  - e. Disciple scheduling
  - f. Oversight of House Maintenance, Cleaning, Shopping, etc...
  - g. Coordination with local congregation and other ministries serving and attendance
- 2. Volunteers
  - a. Leading Prayer/Worship
  - b. Discipleship training
  - c. Counseling when appropriate
  - d. Participation alongside Disciples in daily tasks
- 3. Disciples
  - a. Daily devotional and prayer
  - b. House Maintenance: repairs, cleaning, cooking, shopping, gardening
  - c. Participation in serving at local congregation and house corporate prayer/worship
  - d. Attendance at local congregational meetings
  - e. Ulpan language study for new immigrants
