



As part of a team that's in preparation in prayer to ultimately travel to Poland for a prayer mission, this prayer request came before us regarding a situation that's unfolding in Poland (and Hungary) now. (November 2020)

The EU is trying to pass a Covid relief bill for the European Union totaling 1.8 trillion Euros. But it needs the consent of all 28 member countries to pass.

Poland and Hungary oppose the bill because it stipulates that financial relief will only be given to the countries that "respect the rule of law" What does this mean?

On the surface it applies to the free movement of migrants throughout the EU. But at the end of the day it's a lot more than that.

It also means bowing to and adopting many of the godless humanistic philosophies the EU espouses. Beyond compromising a nation's freedom to determine its own immigration and economic policies, it will ultimately impinge on their religious freedoms as well, touching issues of abortion, the LGBTQ agenda, transgenderism etc.

Both Poland and Hungary are zealous to maintain their identity as Christian countries along with all that entails.

Your prayers would be appreciated because the matter is pressing. Angela Merkel will be mandated to mediate this dispute with a view to coming up with some kind of compromise.

Scriptures to release blessings over individual nations, political leaders, the Body of Messiah, our families and loved ones, our enemies:

Numbers 6:22-27 ²² Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²³ “Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, ‘In this way you shall bless the sons of Israel. You are to say to them: ²⁴ The LORD bless you, and keep you; ²⁵ The LORD cause His face to shine on you, And be gracious to you; ²⁶ The LORD lift up His face to you, And give you peace (shalom).’ ²⁷ So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and *then* I will bless them.”

Example: Lord we bless the sons of Israel. Lord, bless them. Cause Your face to shine on them and be gracious to them. Lift up Your face to them and give them shalom in the fullness of what the word means: peace, prosperity, safety, completeness, health, rest and wholeness. Place Your Name and Your Presence upon them and bless them as You lead them in Your ways.

Eph. 1:2-3 ² Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ³ Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

Example: We bless the Body of Christ with grace and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be You, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. Bless Your Body Lord with a greater understanding of this truth and the ability to walk it out in practical ways – in Jesus’ Name.

Deut. 28:1-7 “Now it shall be, if you diligently obey the LORD your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I am commanding you today, that the LORD your God will put you high above all the nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings will come to you and reach you if you obey the LORD your God: ³ “Blessed *will you be* in the city, and blessed *will you be* in the country. ⁴ “Blessed *will be* the children of your womb, the produce of your ground, and the offspring of your animals: the newborn of your herd and the young of your flock. ⁵ “Blessed *will be* your basket and your kneading bowl. ⁶ “Blessed *will you be* when you come in, and blessed *will you be* when you go out. ⁷ “The LORD will cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated by you; they will go out against you one way and will flee at your presence seven

ways. ⁸The LORD will command the blessing for you in your barns and in everything that you put your hand to, and He will bless you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.

Example: Lord we bless the leaders of all governments with the desire and ability to diligently obey You. Help them to be careful to do all Your commandments. Give them understanding that if they obey You that untold blessings will fall upon the cities, countries, economies and people that they govern. Bless them with understanding that You will cause them to defeat the enemies that rise up against them when they obey Your Word. Bless them Lord with Your Presence, Wisdom and Understanding. Give them courage necessary for obedience.

Ps. 84:11-13 For the LORD God is a sun and shield; The LORD gives grace and glory; He withholds no good thing from those who walk with integrity. ¹²LORD of armies, Blessed is the person who trusts in You!

Example: Lord, You are a sun and shield for my family. Give them grace and glory. Withhold no good thing from them as You help them to walk with integrity. Help them to trust You so they can walk in the blessings of the Lord of armies.

Ps. 146:5-10 Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, Whose hope is in the LORD his God, ⁶Who made heaven and earth, The sea and everything that is in them; Who keeps faith forever; ⁷Who executes justice for the oppressed; Who gives food to the hungry. The LORD frees the prisoners. ⁸The LORD opens *the eyes of* those who are blind; The LORD raises up those who are bowed down; The LORD loves the righteous. ⁹The LORD watches over strangers; He supports the fatherless and the widow, But He thwarts the way of the wicked. ¹⁰The LORD will reign forever, Your God, Zion, to all generations. Praise the LORD!

Example: Lord thank You for making the peoples of this nation hope in You. Bless them as You execute justice for the oppressed, give food to the hungry, free the prisoners, open the eyes of the blind, raise up those who are bowed down. Bless them with the desire for righteousness. Thank You that You watch over the strangers, support the fatherless and widow and thwart the way of the wicked. You reign in this nation forever. HalleluYah!

2 Cor. 9:8 ⁸ And God is able to make all grace overflow to you, so that, always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

Example: Lord thank You for making all grace overflow this household so that we have sufficiency in everything. Bless us with an abundance for every good deed.

Ps. 31:13-24 For I have heard the slander of many, Terror is on every side; While they took counsel together against me, They schemed to take away my life. ¹⁴ But as for me, I trust in You, LORD, I say, “You are my God.” ¹⁵ My times are in Your hand; Rescue me from the hand of my enemies and from those who persecute me. ¹⁶ Make Your face shine upon Your servant; Save me in Your faithfulness. ¹⁷ Let me not be put to shame, LORD, for I call upon You; Let the wicked be put to shame, let them be silent in Sheol. ¹⁸ Let the lying lips be speechless, Which speak arrogantly against the righteous With pride and contempt. ¹⁹ How great is Your goodness, Which You have stored up for those who fear You, Which You have performed for those who take refuge in You, Before the sons of mankind! ²⁰ You hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the conspiracies of mankind; You keep them secretly in a shelter from the strife of tongues. ²¹ Blessed be the LORD, For He has shown His marvelous faithfulness to me in a besieged city. ²² As for me, I said in my alarm, “I am cut off from Your eyes”; Nevertheless You heard the sound of my pleadings When I called to You for help. ²³ Love the LORD, all His godly ones! The LORD watches over the faithful But fully repays the one who acts arrogantly. ²⁴ Be strong and let your heart take courage, All you who wait for the LORD.

Example: Lord, You’ve heard the slander of many. Terror is on every side all over the world. There are those who are scheming to take away our lives. As for us Lord we trust in You and say “You are our God.” Our times are in Your hand. Rescue us from the hand of our enemies and from those who persecute us. Bless us by making Your face to shine upon us, Your servants. Save us in Your faithfulness. Put the wicket to shame. Let the lying lips be speechless. Bless us with Your goodness because we fear You and we take refuge in You. Thank You for the blessing of being hidden in the secret place of Your presence from the conspiracies of mankind and for keeping us secretly in a shelter from the strife of tongues. Blessed are You Lord! You are faithful. We love You. Thank You for the blessing of watching over us. Keep us faithful and courageous as we wait for You.

Ps. 119:1-5 Blessed are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the Law of the LORD. ²Blessed are those who comply with His testimonies *and* seek Him with all *their* heart. ³They also do no injustice; They walk in His ways.

⁴You have ordained Your precepts that we are to keep *them* diligently.

⁵Oh that my ways may be established To keep Your statutes!

Example: Lord we lift up our enemies to You. Bless them by leading them in repentance, so that their ways are blameless. Help them walk in the Law of the Lord and comply with Your testimonies. Turn their hearts of stone to hearts of flesh so that they desire to seek You with all their hearts. Turn them from injustice and help them walk in Your ways, and keep Your statutes.

Ps. 1:1-3 Blessed is the person who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers! ²But his delight is in the Law of the LORD, And on His Law he meditates day and night.³He will be like a tree planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season, And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers.

Example: Lord we lift up our government leaders and bless them so that they don't walk in the counsel of the wicked, stand in the path of sinners, or sit in the seat of scoffers. Bless them with new levels of delight in Your law Lord. Bless them with the ability to meditate on Your law day and night. Show them that then they'll be like trees planted by streams of water, yielding fruit and continuously prospering.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, and whose trust is the LORD. ⁸For he will be like a tree planted by the water That extends its roots by a stream, And does not fear when the heat comes; But its leaves will be green, And it will not be anxious in a year of drought, Nor cease to yield fruit.

Example: Lord we lift up our families and loved ones in the Body of Christ. Bless them with greater abilities to trust in You, Lord. Show them that then, they'll be like trees planted by water. Help them not to fear when heat comes. Bless them and remove all anxiety from them and make them fruitful for Your Kingdom.

Is. 26:1-4 **26** On that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: “We have a strong city; He sets up walls and ramparts for security. ² Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter, The one that remains faithful. ³ The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in You. ⁴ Trust in the LORD forever, For in GOD the LORD, *we have an everlasting Rock.*

Example: Lord, we lift up the nation of Israel and we declare over the land of Judah that today You would bless her with strength and security from all her enemies. We bless the people with true righteousness that only comes from faith in the Messiah of Israel. Open the gates Lord. Stir up faithfulness in Your People. Bless them with steadfast minds that trust in You, the everlasting Rock. As a result, give them the double portion of shalom: Peace, prosperity, safety, completeness, health, rest and wholeness.

2 Samuel 22

Example: Lord, bless us with greater understanding that You are our rock, fortress and deliverer. We bless You for You are our shield and You save us from our enemies. We call to You Lord. Thank You that You hear and act on our behalf, in mighty ways that confound our strong enemies. Bless those that hate us Lord. We bless them as You are our support. Bless us as You set us on our high places and train our hands for battle. Your help makes us great and our feet do not slip beneath us. We pursue our enemies with these prayers of blessing and eliminate them, as You give us strength for battle. Bless our enemies with humility and repentance to bow down under us; and turn their backs to us. Thank You Lord for making us the head of the nation, our rightful place because you execute vengeance for us and bring down people under us. We bless You Lord for raising us above those who rise up against us. We will give thanks to You, Lord and sing praises to Your Name.

Prov. 21:1 The king’s heart is *like* channels of water in the hand of the LORD; He turns it wherever He pleases.

Example: Lord we bless the kings of the earth. We bless their hearts to be like channels of water in Your hand. We bless You Father, for turning their hearts wherever You please.
